REQUIREMENTS FOR VEHICLES BEING BROUGHT ONTO THE EXHIBIT FLOOR

If you are an exhibiting company and wish to bring a vehicle on to the exhibit floor, there are requirements and restrictions to meet for NEMTAC, Orange County, Florida Fire Marshal, JW Marriott Grande Lakes and US Tradeshows. Notify NEMTAC and US Tradeshows of your intent to have a vehicle by **JULY 27, 2026**. Vehicle description including length, width and approximate weight is required.

There will be a round trip Vehicle Mobile Spot fee of \$185.00 per vehicle. This fee covers:

- A.) Inclusion and submission of vehicle information on exhibit floor plan to the Orange County, Florida Fire Marshal for approval.
- B.) Coordination and approval with JW Marriott Grande Lakes.
- C.) Vehicle will be brought in and removed by US Tradeshows personnel.
 - Including escorting the vehicle, and clearing equipment and furnishings from the pathway.
 - Providing floor protection for transport as well as under the vehicle while in the exhibit booth space.
 - Disconnecting and reconnecting the battery cables.
 - Securing the gas tank cover if needed.
 - Coordinating hotel air circulation shutdown operation with Marriott personnel during both delivery and removal.

Fire Marshal requirements for all vehicles:

- D.) **Fuel tank must be less than 1/4 of a tank, or 10 gallons. Whichever is less.** If there is more than 1/4 of a tank of fuel, then fuel must either be taken to a mechanic for syphoning or driven around the area until enough fuel is used to meet the requirement.
- E.) Gas cap must be lockable and locked. If vehicle does not have a lockable tank, then it must be covered and taped securely shut.
- F.) Battery cables must be disconnected.
- G.) Keys must be left in control of US Tradeshows so they are accessible at all times for emergency.

In order to ensure ease of delivery and removal of your vehicle, scheduling delivery and removal of vehicle must be arranged in advance with US Tradeshows. We must allow the show floor to be clear after the break of the event before we will be able to remove the vehicle safely.
